

Summertime Fun & Safety

Prepare, Prevent & Protect Your Dogs from Heat

Prepare by conditioning, grooming, improving hydration and applying sunscreen

Proper conditioning of dog gradually in preparation of activities

Ideal body composition achieved through feeding correct calories over time

De-shedding achieved through brushing/bathing; Furminator, Zoom Groom

Plan trips by researching directions to adventure locations, sunrise/sunset times, predicted temperatures/weather there

Moist dog food: The Honest Kitchen food reconstituted each meal

Electrolyte beverages: Ice Pups as liquid or ice cubes in dog's water

Liquids prior to activities-Pro-Bloom Goat's Milk Powder, low sodium Chicken Broth

Sunscreen spray; Epipet skin protectant

Snout Soother; nose protectant

Dog's normal body temperature premeasured

Prevent heat-related stresses by hydrating and keeping cool

Water Sources: always take water with you no matter how short the trip

Portable bowls for beverages on the go; Sandia Pet

Collapsible silicone bowls; Bamboo & Dexas

Water bottles: H2O4K9 stainless bottle with cup lid

Car travel water bowl: To Go Bowl to use while traveling

Dog sunglasses: Doggles for eye protection

Protective socks: Pawk Dog Socks for quick hot-surface crossings

Cooling vest: Ruffwear Swamp Cooler

Dog wipes: Earthbath Hypoallergenic Wipes-add water

Infrared temp gun for surface temperature readings (to know where not to walk)

Protect by monitoring and cooling down

Thermometer for assessing dog's temp, also watch for abnormal behaviors

Car thermometer: Too Hot for Spot!

Frozen Treats: Yoghund Frozen Dog Treats

Frozen Toys with food: Kong with homemade stuffing

Fans, Circulating and ceiling

Hose & Kiddie Pool

Cold water source

Ice Packs
